



International tourists coming into the country spend at least 2,073 USD per capita. Also, compared to 9 nights in 2019, tourists now stay an average of over 11 nights in the country, while 70 percent are repeat visitors.









International tourist arrivals worldwide since 1990




### WPI Consolidated Revenue 2024




#### WPI ROOMS Revenue 2024




#### WPIFOOD & BEVERAGE Revenue 2024




### WPI RENT & RELATED Income 2024






### WPI COSTS AND EXPENSES 2024


